1. Financial Need Box (Yes or No) [either 0 or 4]

- a. On your honor, do you think you are in need of financial aid?
- b. Explanation box (optional) i.e. if you have other siblings in college or private school, financial changes due to Covid-19

2. OYFA enthusiasm and dedication essay [1-5]

- a. Describe what OYFA means to you and its impact during your first year?
 - 5** - Statement is well-organized, detailed, and directly related to the question. The applicant presents a unique and carefully thought answer that demonstrates enthusiasm and dedication for the organization. The applicant highlights specific contributions to the organization and how it has impacted their experience at UVA.
 - 4** - Statement is slightly lacking in relevance and organization. The applicant presents a carefully thought out answer that highlights some experiences with OYFA and the impacts of these experiences.
 - 3** - Statement needs work on organization and staying on task. Details are lacking and do not show specific contributions to and impacts of OYFA.
 - 2** - Statement's lack of organization and details gets in the way of understanding the statement. The applicant presents an unclear and irrelevant answer that does not shed a light on their experiences with OYFA.
 - 1** - Statement is left unanswered.

3. Academic excellence [1-5]

- a. Describe a recent accomplishment in your academic experience that you are proud of.
 - 5** - Statement is well-organized, detailed, and stays on task. The applicant presents a unique and carefully thought out answer that stands out. The applicant highlights their growth, change, or work ethic throughout experience or accomplishment as a student.
 - 4** - Statement is mostly organized yet might need some work on providing details and remaining on task. The applicant presents a carefully thought out answer that highlights their strengths throughout experience or accomplishment as a student.
 - 3** - Statement needs work on organization and staying on task. Details are lacking and do not contribute to the highlights of their experience or accomplishment as a student.
 - 2** - Statement's lack of organization and details gets in the way of understanding the statement. The applicant presents an unclear and irrelevant answer that does not shed a light on their accomplishments as a student.
 - 1** - Statement is left unanswered.

4. Extra-curricular [1-2]

- a. List some extra-curricular activities or work experiences that you are currently involved in or have been involved in this past year and briefly describe your role in each.

5. Community service essay [1-3]

- a. Describe one way you have impacted your community.

3 - Statement is well-organized, detailed, and stays on task. The applicant presents a very unique and carefully thought out answer that stands out. The applicant highlights a specific example of how they have impacted their community and the importance of this experience.

2 - Statement is organized but could use more details. The applicant displays some example of a way they impacted ed their ir community, but does not demonstrate importance or significance of impact.

1 - The applicant does not demonstrate a significant impact on their community, and is lacking in details.

6. Leadership essay [1-3]

- a. Describe one experience in which you have demonstrated leadership qualities.

3 – Statement is well-organized, detailed, and stays on task. The applicant presents a unique and carefully thought out answer that stands out. The applicant demonstrates many key characteristics and values of a leader such as good communication skills, determination, responsibility, etc.

2 – Statement is organized but could use more details. The applicant demonstrates some key characteristics and values of a leader such as good communication skills, determination, responsibility, etc.

1 – Lack of organization and details gets in the way of a clear understanding of the statement. The applicant does not demonstrate key characteristics and values of a leader.

7. Discretionary Question [1-3]

- a. The theme of Barrio this year is Pagbabago: Change. Tell us about a time when you adapted to a major change in your life and how that experience shaped you into the person you are today.

3 – Statement is well-organized, detailed, and stays on task. The applicant presents a very unique and carefully thought out answer that stands out. The applicant highlights the importance and personal connection that they have to their culture.

2 – Statement is organized but could use more details. The applicant presents an idea that is unoriginal and highlights the importance of their culture.

1 – Lack of organization and details gets in the way of a clear understanding of the statement. The applicant does not demonstrate finding clarity nor any importance.
